Adam's talent rewarded

It will be a night of firsts for Orange Regional Conservatorium (ORC) student Adam Sadler at the Music in the Gardens concert on Friday 5 March.

A Year 8 student at St Stanislaus College in Bathurst, and a music student at the ORC, Adam will walk onto the stage for the first time as a member of the Orange Symphony Orchestra.

A passionate violinist, Adam will be in the spotlight that evening as he receives recognition for his dedication to music as the first regional student to be awarded the use of an instrument from the National Instrument Bank.

Adam will receive his Russell Violin at the final Music in the Gardens concert next Friday by a representative from the NMBA. He will be able to use this instrument for the remainder of the year as he endeavours to become a more proficient musician.

Adam has been a student of ORC violin teacher, Andrew Baker's for 5 years and is preparing 6th Grade violin AMEB. "Adam is a very dedicated, involved and talented student," Mr Baker said. "He has previously won first prize in the ORC Violin competition and in many sections in the Orange Eisteddfod."
